


LIAM NELSON (Charlie Brown (A) / Shermy (B))


LIAM KAUFMAN (Charlie Brown (B) / Shermy (A))


SHELBY REARDON (Sally (A) / Tapioca Pudding (B))


ELLIE ALLRED (Sally (B) / Tapioca Pudding (A))


GAVIN WARD (Schroeder (A) / Larry (B))


JOSHUA GLENN (Linus (A) / Floyd (B))


AVA SCHROADER (Woodstock (A) / Sophie (B))


LILAH JACOBSEN (Woodstock (B) / Sophie (A))


ADELAIDE SUAZO (Violet)

TAYLOR TENNISON (Marcie)






ELLIE KENNEDY (Patty)

ANNIE TELFORD (Lydia)


